All tours and experiences run Monday to Friday. We run tours from 10am-3pm. We are a working brewery and there are likely to be puddles on the brewery floor, we'd ask that you wear suitable footwear that have sufficient grip and you don't mind getting a little bit wet. Therefore stilettoes and flip flops are not recommended! If coming during the winter please wrap up warm as it can get cold on the brewery floor.

Brewer For a Day (8:30am-4:00pm approx.)

Our 'Brewer for a Day' days are a great, hands-on experience that give you a real insight into the job of our brewers. The brewers will guide you through our brewing process step by step and you can get your hands as dirty (and beery) as you like.

As you will be getting involved with a fairly messy process, we'd ask that you wear appropriate clothing (anything you don't mind getting dirty) and suitable footwear such as wellingtons or tatty trainers.

You will be provided a tasty lunch so please do let us know if anyone in your party has any dietary requirements.

After you have worked up a sweat in the brewery there will be the opportunity to sample some of the beers we brew here. If you are taking part in the sampling, we would highly recommend that you make arrangements to use public transport or get someone to collect you.

Design Your Own Beer (9:30am-3:30pm approx.)

Our 'Design Your Own Beer' days are a great, hands-on experience that give you a chance to brew your new favourite beer. Please take some time to consider what type of beer you would like to brew and let us know a few weeks before. This gives us a chance to prepare as best as possible for what beer you want to brew and possibly source any special ingredients should we need to. The brewers will guide you through our brewing process step by step and you can get your hands as dirty (and beery) as you like.

You will be provided a tasty lunch so please do let us know if anyone in your party has any dietary requirements.

While you are hard at work designing your beer and the label there will be the opportunity to sample some of the beers we brew here. If you are taking part in the sampling, we would highly recommend that you make arrangements to use public transport or get someone to collect you.

As part of the experience you will receive 6 cases (72 bottles!) of your delicious beer, lucky you! The beer will need to be collected from the brewery. If this is not possible we can arrange for the beer to be couriered to an address of your choice. There is an additional cost for this service, which covers our postage costs.

How to get to the Brewery



From Chester: Turn off A55 at junction 23, then follow signs to Old Colwyn. Follow the dual carriageway which then becomes a single carriageway passing a quarry, then take a left onto Highlands Road. Go up the hill passing Peulwys estate on your right, then take the right fork onto Tan y Graig Road. After a 100 yards turn right at the Ty Mawr stables sign onto a track leading to Conwy Brewery which is the large green industrial unit on your right.

From Conwy: Turn off A55 at junction 22, then follow signs to Old Colwyn. Go through Old Colwyn and go up the hill, past the Llysfaen turn off, keep going uphill until you see Highlands Road on your right. Then follow directions as above.
